### Mission Work Team, Summer Bible Clubs, Mountain Retreats and Conferences

The new mission in **Tamazula** opened its doors on June 14. A work team from Westside Baptist Church from St. George, UT, came to help us get ready. They did a wonderful job putting a new face on a building that had been shut for over a year.



Even though summer in central Sinaloa was hot with less rain this year, the work of church planting continues with greater participation from our local church family. From June 27 to August 15 we held Saturday afternoon Bible clubs. Steady attendance (35 children and several adults) provided the opportunity to plant and water the seeds of the Gospel. **Abigail and Karely** led the outreach along with the help of other teenagers. The ministry continues with a Thursday night children's church and monthly youth activities aimed at evangelizing the next generation.



In August, 38 folks in six vehicles travelled for four hours up into the mountains to attend a three-day retreat entitled: "*The Ministry of Marriage*." Our men brought devotionals twice a day,

families met together to read **and** pray, and between the hiking and exploring the beauties of God's creation, we fit in five sessions of preaching and teaching. Several families attended for the first time — all want to do it again but stay an extra day!



For the special **Mexican Independence holidays** on Sept. 15-16 we held a two-day conference on prophecy coupled with patriotic costumes and abundant tri-color decorations and a delicious potluck dinner. We had visitors from four sister churches and our deacons enacted the traditional "grito — 'Viva Mexico'" [traditional victory shout for Independence Day].



This summer the Lord healed wounded spirits, motivated saints to serve, and spread the Gospel using the combined efforts of young and old[er!] alike. . . God is good! Praise Him for using "unprofitable servants".
